Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are well and beginning to enjoy the relaxation of some of the COVID related restrictions.

Your child has been allocated a place at St Michael's Church of England Academy which is a member of the Learning Academy Partnership Trust. We are delighted that you have chosen St Michael's Church of England Academy for your child and look forward to the many years of partnership we will share to support your child's education and upbringing, as they grow into talented and bright young people.

We continue to work hard to ensure that St Michael's will be an excellent school for your child, with outstanding facilities and opportunities, which they will be able to access throughout their years with us. Now that your child's place has been confirmed, we are excited to begin the induction process and get to know you and your child a little more.

To support you and your child get ready for September we have organised a number of welcome events between now and the start of the next academic year. We recognise that this is a significant step in your child's life, so we hope these events can help prepare you and your children for starting school.

We will be holding plenty of events, some of which we hope will be face-to-face, although that is dependent on COVID restrictions at the time. We hope these events will enable you to become familiar with the other families joining the school and with the school and wider Trust team.

For our first event we would like to invite you to an online welcome meeting via Zoom. The date for this meeting is 5.00 pm Monday 24th May. This meeting is important, and we urge all parents and carers to attend. It is an opportunity for you to meet myself and Mrs May our Senior Administrator, and gather information about how we operate, our offer to you, our expectations and everything that you need to know ready for September.

We have also confirmed with the Department for Education that despite the extensive work currently being undertaken across the school site, we will have secure classrooms on site, which will be ready for the different induction activities we have planned over the summer, and for the pupils to begin their learning in September.

This space will be a temporary location on the school site, adjacent to the Language School, which is on the school premises. This will mean we are able to acclimatise the children to their school environment in the first term, and then will transfer over to the main building once works are fully completed.

Excitingly, this also means that we will be able to hold transition events in the Summer Term on the St Michael's premises, so that you and your child can visit our Early Years classrooms and will feel more confident about starting school in September.
