HOME LEARNING


For home learning this week we would like you to enjoy the long (hopefully sunny) weekend with your friends and family.

Dear Parents & Carers

Welcome back to the start of the Summer term! This term we have started our curriculum learning of 'Let's Investigate...' by investigating the growth of plants and flowers. This week we have planted beans, beetroot, potatoes and tomatoes in school. We have explored different seeds and were amazed at the idea that you can get more potatoes from a single potato! We will be watching the plants grow over the next few weeks and hopefully be able to harvest some tasty vegetables soon.



Our story this week has been 'The Tiny Seed' by Eric Carle. A small seed is carried aloft by the autumn wind, the tiny seed, along with other bigger seeds, travels far over the world. The journey is perilous: one of the bigger seeds is burned by the sun; another falls into the ocean and another is eaten by a bird! We have learnt about the life cycle of plants and will continue to explore this in the next few weeks.

In maths this week we have been learning about doubling. The children have met the doubling machine, which doubles everything you put into it! We all found this very funny indeed.
