HOME LEARNING

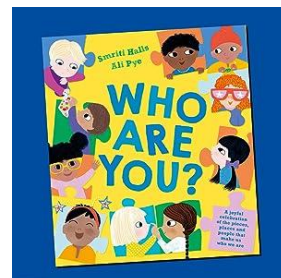
Each week we will continue to set an activity to share at home. These activities are designed to support the learning we are doing in school.
