Next week the children will be using these pictures to think about all the ways they have changed since they were born.

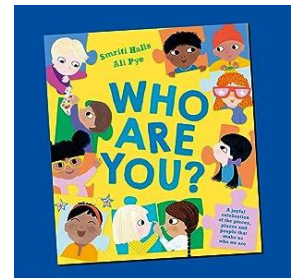
We are happy for these to be on Tapestry or we can take photocopies of originals if it is easier.



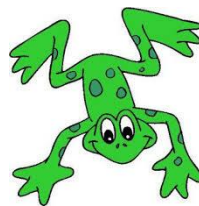
Dear parents and carers
