Soft Bear will continue to choose a friend to go home with each weekend. He will bring his bag and a special book to share.

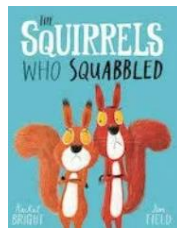
Soft Bear loves reading and would enjoy seeing the special stories you have at home too!
