If your child is in reception:

In the memos section of Tapestry there are some short sound videos linked to the sounds we are learning in school. Please take some time to watch these with your children.

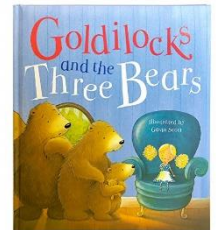
If your child is in nursery:

Can you build in time this week to chat through getting ready to go out?

Before heading out for the day or for a short trip, encourage your child to **go to the window and check the weather**. Ask them, 'what's the weather like today?' When they answer, **ask them about what they might need to wear based on the weather**, e.g. 'What do you wear when it's raining?' or 'What do you need when it's sunny?' Talking through going out helps **build language learning into everyday routines and makes them more fun too!**

In this wonderful traditional story a young girl walking in the woods discovers an empty house that belongs to a family of bears, she sets about making herself comfortable by eating their food and using their belongings!



In class, our home corner became the three bear's cottage. We had lots of fun playing and retelling the story together and even more fun making and tasting porridge too! The children were challenged to think about who the good and bad characters are in the story. Is it who you first think? We talked about the characters and how they behaved in the story. Did the bears actually do anything bad? Does Goldilocks make good choices?

Maths this week has been all about the number 3. We made collections of three things and thought about how a triangle had three points/sides. The children enjoyed making pictures from three sided shapes.

In PE this week we practiced our jumping, hopping and balancing skills. We enjoyed the challenge of doing the crab whilst holding a beanbag on our tummy!
