If your child is in reception:

Please look on the memos section of tapestry for updated videos.

If your child is in nursery:

Can you play 'Name and catch' with a ball.

If you're in a group, you can ask everyone to say the name of the person they want to throw the ball to before they throw it.

If your child finds this game too easy, try giving everyone a number or the name of an animal or fruit? They must then say the number, animal name, or fruit of the person they want to throw the ball to.

This game can help develop memory and concentration skills.

Our story this week has been the traditional tale of 'The Gingerbread Man'. The children have LOVED this story and have enjoyed using actions to help retell the story together. We thought about the repeated phrases in the story and used our storyteller voices to say them each time with expression.



In maths this week the children used Pentominoes to subitise up to five. They were challenged to rotate different pieces to work out which one fit a template. The children worked hard to describe the pieces that would fit using lots of positional language and spatial reasoning.


