If your child is in reception:

Please use the memos section of Tapestry to find updated word reading videos for your child.

If your child is in nursery:

Can you play 'what's in the bag?'. A sensory bag can be as simple as a pillowcase or other container filled with several objects with different textures. You may need to introduce the objects first so that your child has seen and touched them and heard what they are called. This will help them imagine the objects once you hide them.

When your child puts their hand in the bag, they will feel and experience lots of different textures, which you can talk about together.


Why not let your child try to guess what's in the bag before taking it out? Use open questions and encourage lots of descriptive vocabulary.

This requires them to use their other senses to identify the object and the word linked to it.
