Spring 1	Year 2
Class Novel	This term, we will be sharing, "Space Band" with the children. After the popularity of The Christmasaurus, the children were given the chance to vote on which book they would like to have as our class novel next. They so enjoyed the way Tom Fletcher wrote, that they were very keen for another of his adventure books.
Reading and Writing	In Read, Write Inc this half term the children will continue to learn their set 1, 2 and 3 sounds. They will then apply their knowledge when looking at a range of texts including fiction and nonfiction. The children will explore the texts through guided reading exercises, partner practice and creative/informative writing.
Maths	Our Maths will focus on multiplication and division. The children will learn to make equal groups, they will learn to add these together as the beginnings of multiplication and will learn about sharing for division. Once we have completed this unit of learning, we will move on to Statistics.
Science	This half term in science we will be exploring Animals including Humans. The children will learn about food chains and the interconnectedness of all living things as well as the life cycles of different animals. We will pay close attention to the life stages of animals and take a look into how to stay healthy as a human.
RE	In RE this term, we will be exploring the question, "What do Christians believe God is like?" We will be learning about parables and how Christians believe these were used by Jesus to teach his followers about God and how to live their lives. We will be using, "The Lost Son" to focus on for much of this unit.
Geography	As geographers this half term, we will be building on our learning from Year 1 about the United Kingdom. We will be learning about the four capital cities of the UK's four countries, the seas and oceans that surround the UK as well as learning about weather and seasonal changes.
PE	In PE this term, the children will be learning to play a number of different invasion games, as well as gymnastics.
RHE	Our focus in relationships and health education this term is belonging to a community and Media Literacy and Digital Resilience.
Music	In music, we will be learning about Rock music. Using Charanga, they will follow the theme of, "I Wanna Play in a Band." This fits beautifully with the class novel the children have chosen and they will sing, learn to play along to and appreciate rock music.
Computing	This half term, we will develop an understanding of what information technology is and identify examples of it. We will discuss where we have seen it in school and beyond and consider how it improves the world around us.
Art	This term in Art, the children will focus on the art of Clover Robin. She is a local artist that works using collage. The children will begin to understand what collage is and make their own piece based upon her works.
