Could you help the children to think about their special place and share a photo on Tapestry please. We will be using these photos to help us in our RE learning next week.

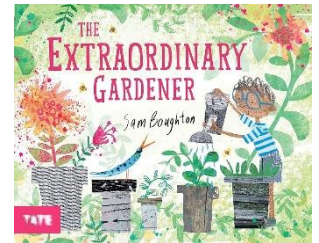
Reception children: please continue to watch your sound videos read/ your words/books as much as you can with your grownups at home.

Our text this week has been the story 'The Extraordinary Gardener' By Sam Boughton. In this beautifully illustrated book, Joe is a boy just like any other, but Joe loves to imagine.
