Reception children: please continue to watch your sound videos read/ your words/books as much as you can with your grownups at home.

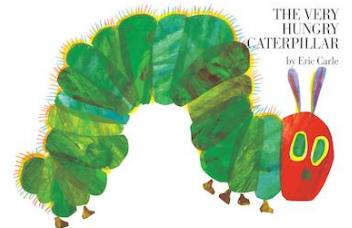
We recommend at least three times in the week to help develop fluency.
