We would love to see some of you exploring on Tapestry.

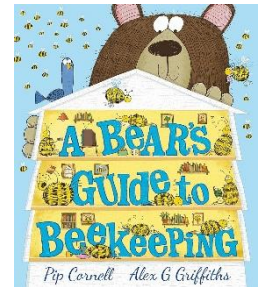
Reception children: please continue to watch your sound videos read/ your words/books as much as you can with your grownups at home.
