HOME LEARNING

Nursery Children: Can you play a game of eye spy this week. Take turns with one another to pick an item you can see around you.

Say 'I spy with my little eye something beginning with...' saying the sound that the object's name begins with, **not** the letter's name. So for example, 'I spy with my little eye, something beginning with sss' (S).

By using the sound as opposed to the name, you're helping your little one to spot the word sound, which is helpful when it comes to learning to read.

Reception children: please continue to watch your sound videos read/ your words/books as much as you can with your grownups at home.

We recommend **at least three** times in the week to help develop fluency.
